### REGISTERED BEEF CATTLE CLASSES

Rules are the same as Open Class Dairy Cattle. Beef animals must be entered on Wednesday, August 12th by 6:00 p.m. and must stay throughout the fair. Each animal may exhibit in only one lot with the exception of group classes where an animal may be entered in more than one group lot.

However, cow/calf pairs may be split up so mothers can show in cow class and calves can show in Heifer less than one year and Bull or Steer less than one year.

#### Lot

1. Cow/Calf

Calf must be cow's natural calf, not embryo transplant.

Calf to be no more than 250 days of age by day of show. No age restrictions on cow. Calf not eligible to compete in individual calf classes if shown with dam. Pair is eligible for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female. Entry covers both animals.

3. Cow 4 years & older
4. Heifer Senior Yearling - 9/1/07 to 12/31/07
5. Heifer Junior Yearling - 1/1/08 to 4/30/08
6. Heifer Summer Yearling - 5/1/08 to 8/31/08

8. Junior Heifer Calf - Born after 1/1/09

#### Lot

22. Produce of Dam (2 animals from same dam)  
Produce of Dam - two animals, either sex, from one dam, to be shown in individual classes to be eligible. May be shown by more than one exhibitor.
23. Pairs of Heifers (2 heifers from the same herd)

24. Get of Sire (3 animals with same sire)

**Junior Get of Sire** - 3 animals all by one sire, both sexes to be represented, may be shown by more than one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in their Individual classes to be eligible.

**Get of Sire** - 4 animals, all by one sire, both sexes to be represented, may be owned by more than one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible. This get must have a minimum of two animals born before September 1, 2004 for the group to be eligible for the get of sire competition.

25. 5 Head - 5 animals of either sex, owned by exhibitor from either the calf classes, junior classes, the senior classes or any combination.

26. Breeder's Herd - 4 animals, either sex, bred and owned by exhibitor. All animals must be shown in their individual classes to be eligible.

#### Premier Exhibitor Award

This award to be made to the exhibitor winning the most money but not to exceed ten animals shown in one breed and exhibited by himself in the open single class. (No limit on number exhibited, but award automatically figured on top ten animals in one breed winning the most money.) No trophy will be awarded if there is no competition.

#### SHEEP FROM MINNESOTA

No health certificate required.

Sheep must be identified with official identification approved for use in the scrapie eradication program. Sheep will be inspected by the official veterinarian before being unloaded on the opening day of the exhibition and daily during the exhibition. The official veterinarian will order the immediate removal to a quarantine facility or removal from the exhibition premises of any sheep with symptoms of infections or communicable disease. This includes sheep with warts or ringworm.

The exhibition management has the authority to adopt additional requirements. (Check with exhibition secretary).

1. Entry fee shall be \$2.50 per head regardless of the number of head entered.
2. The base dates for computing age of yearlings shall be Sept. 1, 2007 and after.
3. The base dates for computing age of fall lambs shall be Sept. 1 - Dec. 31, 2007.
4. The base dates for computing age of winter lambs shall be Jan. 1 - Feb. 15, 2008.
5. The base dates for computing age of junior lambs shall be Feb. 15, 2008 and younger.
6. There will be a limit of two entries in Individual lots and a limit of 1 entry in groups.
7. A flock must consist of 1 ram and 3 ewes of any age.
8. A Get of Sire must consist of 4 head of both sexes.
9. All entrants must have registration papers available for inspection.
10. There will be a limit of 1 market lamb per exhibitor.
