RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The LIONS Club, Nicollet County Fair Board or Members and/or Personal Property Owners are not responsible for accident, injury or theft.
2. Drivers must be 16 years or older (16-17 yrs. MUST have guardian authorization; authorization must be NOTARIZED).
3. NO IMPERIALS.
4. All windows, glass, taillights, plastic grills and headlights must be removed from the car prior to arrival. Windows cannot just be rolled down.
5. All chrome, loose trim and the back seat must be removed from car.
6. **NO REINFORCEMENT ALLOWED!** Cars must remain stock (rims, valve stems, bumpers, radiators, rear end, motor, drive shaft and tires). Stock suspension and shocks only. No preloading of suspension (chain or wire). No air shocks. All markings must be on tires. Tires must not be bigger than P (passenger) 6 ply max. **No skid or implement tires.** No tire inside tire. Nothing in TIRE BUT AIR. Cutting is restricted around diameter of tires. No bending, rolling, bolting or screws of any kind around tires.
7. Doors & trunks must be chained, wired or welded. Must not weld more than 12" per seam. No more than 24" per door or trunk. Nothing wider than 1/4" x 2" flat strap. You may add a driver safety plate, using a 1/2" x 8" flat plate, no longer than 2" more than drivers door width. It must be welded or bolted outside of door. No more than a total of 4" of weld on on top and bottom, Ends will be considered as part of the 12" seam weld of door. No tucking of trunk or wrapping of hood. Back of hood may be mounted with 2 pieces of 2" angle iron 4" long, one welded or bolted to hood, other to top layer of fender only. Max 1/2" bolt holding angle iron together. Hood to be chained or wired only through head lights, fenders, or bumpers. Only one loop chain, cable, or wire (4 strands) around bumper. One on each side. Must be able to inspect inside of trunk. Either a 24" diameter hole from inside of car, or a 16" hole from top.
8. Motor transmission can be wired, chained or cabled, NO FABRICATION. Welded rear ends OK. If frame is rusted out, can add 1/8" x 4" x 1' max plate, leave bottom open so we can inspect for rust. Shock bumpers and mounts are limited to welding half the distance around the shock bumper, two chains, or two cables (may be welded around shock bumper ONLY, NOT the frame). Bumpers have to be bolted on, with no more than 8 bolts, (4 per side, 7/16" MAX)
9. If you move the battery, it must be fastened and covered properly. You may also relocate the coil, the shifter and the key ignition with button or switches.
10. Maximum of five gallons of gas will be allowed in STEEL gas tank. Original gas tank MUST be removed. Secured and covered with nonflammable material. Gas line must be securely fastened.
11. Driver's inside door panel and/or padding REQUIRED.
12. No bumper swapping or reinforced bumpers. No turning bumpers upside down. **(Must Be Stock) Chevy on Chevy, Ford on Ford,** Maximum bumper height 28" to top.
13. Up to 3" dash bar and a single 3" post behind the driver's seat with 6" x 6" end plate will be allowed. A light web will be allowed on the driver's window and directly in front of driver; like livestock panel. Door brace may go across from driver's door to passenger door post, or can angle the brace from car post to floor (NOT THE FRAME). Post may be bolted or welded. You may add a Roll Bar. It will have to be behind the driver seat. It can be mountd to the door to door bar, (and/or) to the tin on floor, **not the frame.**
14. No adding any body mounts to frame! No lift kits, helper springs, over load springs allowed. Rear leaf spring will be stock. Bands stock, or can use a light home made band, one in front of axle, and one in back.
15. Drivers must wear safety helmet, safety belt and long sleeved shirt. Stay in your car and do not take helmet off until heat is over.
16. Front doors & roof fin to have number only in contrasting color. Roof fin is to be minimum 18" X 18". NO CARDBOARD FINs. NO PROFANITY ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON CAR!
17. All vehicles must be in the pit and have passed inspection **ONE HOUR BEFORE PROGRAM. \$20.00 PENALTY FOR LATE SHOW-UPS. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
18. DRIVERS ONLY admitted free.
19. All driver's, cars and pitmen must go to check-in table to sign a waiver and receive wrist band.
20. Entries are limited to 15 cars per heat, get form and money in ASAP to be assured a spot. Preference given to local entries. Entry fee of \$15.00 will admit driver only.
21. All cars must be removed by 9 a.m. the next morning.
22. **NO BEER, ALCOHOL, OR DRUGS MAY BE CONSUMED BEFORE OR DURING DERBY. NO ALCOHOL IN PIT AREA. NO ALCOHOL IN VEHICLES. ALL VIOLATORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE DERBY.**
23. Numbers will be assigned when you register and approval of entry. We will try to honor number requests.
24. All rights to prize money, trophy and entry fee will be forfeited for violation of rules or conduct.
25. A plasma cutter will be on hand; anything suspicious will be checked into. We reserve the right to cut into any frame.
26. We reserve the right to refuse entrance to anyone.
27. HEATS RUN TO FINAL CAR!!!
28. All vehicles will have to be lined up 1/2 hour before derby. You will only have one chance to make your vehicle legal. COMMITTEES DECISION FINAL!

30. If it didn't say it's illegal doesn't mean it's legal. COMMITTEES DECISION FINAL!

ADDITIONAL COMPACT CAR RULES

31. 102" or less wheel base for compact car (6 cyl max must be factory equipped). Max bumper height 26" to top.)

ADDITIONAL TRUCK DERBY RULES

32. 1/2 or 3/4 ton American made pick up truck only. No 4 doors. You can use a 4 wheel drive if front drive shaft is removed.
33. Original gas tank MUST be removed. A steel gas tank must be secured in front part of box (5 gal or so). No frame to frame plating.
34. Can use L. T. tires, but may not exceed load range D or 8 ply. No E or 10 ply tires allowed. No larger than 16.5 tires. All markings must be on tires. **Nothing but pick up tires.**
35. Box may be mounted to frame with bolts or U-Bolts. With max of 8 places. Cab may be mounted to frame with bolts or U-bolts. With max of 8 places including radiator supports and factory mounts. You may bolt box and cab together with up to 4 bolts, or you may weld a short flat strap between box and cab. Not to lap on either box or cab, (1/4 x W x 8 inch max) one on each side. Max bolts and washers are 3/4 bolts & 1/4 x 8" washer. Roll over bar strongly recommended, mount in front of box as close as possible to cab. No wider than frame, maximum height is to top of cab. Can bolt or weld to box, or to washers that hold box to frame. Maximum distance is 2' back on floor with kicker brace. If truck is from last year call to see if OK.
36. Tailgate must be welded to box 12" max per side. (BOX ONLY NOT TO FRAME OR BUMPER)
37. Split rims must be welded.
38. Maximum bumper height 30"
